



Museum of East Anglian Life Stowmarket



The Museum of East Anglian Life is an open-air museum set in 75 acres of countryside in Stowmarket, in the heart of Suffolk.

They tell the story of the region and the people who lived there, through 20 historic buildings, the landscape, rare breeds of animals, gardens and around 40,000 objects.

They hold events throughout the year, family activities during the holidays, offer a schools' programme and much more.

The Museum offers drop in and bookable sessions throughout the open season (late March to November) every school holiday. The sessions may include animation workshops, Mud Bugs and Baking, trails and more.
