The Suffolk Punch Trust was founded to help protect the critically endangered Suffolk horse through its established breeding programme, raising public awareness and training a new generation of professionals to work with these iconic heavy horses.

The Suffolk Punch Trust is dedicated to the preservation of Suffolk's unique history. The Trust is home to the Hollesley Bay Colony Stud which is the world's oldest stud farm breeding the extremely rare Suffolk Horse.

Lots of events and attractions are held and there's an opportunity join the horses and yearlings (with regular stable demonstrations), rare Large Black Pigs, Red Poll Cattle and Suffolk Sheep on a day out.
